Welcome to the November edition of the 35 x 35 for 2020!

All of the backstitches are straight stitches, so each line is a single stitch.

There is no wrong way to do the straight stitches along the sides - I did mine by doing first one direction then the other, but you could do it in alternating directions to weave them together - or perhaps another way I haven't thought of!
