•	[2]	DMC	809	delft blue	(350 stitches, 0.1 skeins)

# [2] DMC 798 delft blue - dk (304 stitches, 0.1 skeins) [2] DMC 820 royal blue - vy dk (419 stitches, 0.1 skeins)

#### **Backstitch Lines:**

 DMC-304	Do NOT stitch!	(0.16 inches, 0.1 skeins)
 DMC-820	royal blue - vy dk	(2.72 inches, 0.1 skeins)
 DMC-701	Only stitch if making a biscornu	(12.67 inches, 0.1 skeins)

# Welcome to the last part of the NYE Mystery!

I hope you enjoyed the SAL and like the back I designed for this.

First: The red line marks the area you will stitch DO NOT STITCH THE RED LINES

Then: The green lines are the stitching lines for making a biscornu. If you are NOT stitching a biscornu you can also ignore these lines!

To save on constantly starting and stopping thread it would be wise to just park the threads to one side till the next part or until you are sure you no longer need that colour.
