As always I have left space in the centre for you to put your initials and a date etc. To show placement I have already added in the mystery details and GS as my initials, obviously you will want to use your own initials, but you may need to remove some of the lower flowers to make space if your initials are more than two letters

As you know I always include a complete alphabet with the back pattern - there are two Q's so you can pick the one you like best.

Feel free to do what you want there - these are just suggestions - I'm a huge fan of changing things up and love seeing what others come up with!
