Welcome to the 22nd part of the Weavers Tapestry Band Sampler SAL!

Notes:

- I have made the pattern 21 stitches high as I noticed that the pattern didn't match the grid of the border due to the border being 11 stitches wide. Since some of you have gridded the fabric this made it possible for you to get misplaced - I will continue to give 21 stitches so that the grid of the weekly pattern remains consistent with that of the border pattern.
- I have made the pattern so it fits on a single page for the pattern and a single page for the notes. It's rotated to landscape mode - I would advise against printing this in portrait mode.
- The light grey/diamond symbol is the border and last week's pattern
- The blue/X symbol is this week's section of pattern, I did it like this so you can colour in where you want which colour should you choose to use more colours.

I hope you have had time to stitch at least the top of the border before today as that will help with placement.

Notes:

- I have made the pattern 21 stitches high as I noticed that last week's pattern didn't match the grid of the border due to the border being 11 stitches wide. Since some of you have gridded the fabric this made it possible for you to get misplaced - I will be continuing to give 21 stitches so that the grid of the weekly pattern remains consistent with that of the border pattern.
- I have made the pattern so it fits on a single page for the pattern and a single page for the notes. This time it's in its entirety and rotated to landscape mode - I would advise against printing this in portrait mode.
- The light grey/diamond symbol is the border and last week's pattern
- The blue/X symbol is this week's section of pattern, I did it like this so you can colour in where you want which colour should you choose to use more colours.

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
