\bigcirc [2]	DMC	444	lemon - dk	(112 stitches, 0.1 skeins)	- [2]	DMC	995	electric blue - dk	(432 stitches, 0.2 skeins)

Backstitch Lines:

DMC-321 christmas red (2.86 inches, 0.1 skeins)

This pattern was created with the FB group "Rainbows for Peace and Comfort" in mind, so the colours used are those that the group uses for all of their blocks. I have left a space in the middle so the name for whom the block is being stitched can be stitched there and left enough space around the block so the stitcher can put their name and state/country there as well.

The premise of the group is as follows:

"This group is formed to help bring comfort and peace to all those impacted by the Orlando tragedy. We are a group of cross stitchers who will be making quilts and other items for all. Please join us by stitching, supporting us and watching the projects grow."
